**Joe Bevilacqua** wants to create a bar, Double Eagle Tavern and a restaurant, La Familia, with separate menus.

He requested: a wall be added to separate the bar from the restaurant  
no outside food or beverages be allowed.  
pizza oven  
be able to lock the bar and restaurant

He feels with those changes that he could run a profitable business.

**Mark Rogers** attended culinary school in Boston and has 27 years experience in the restaurant business. He has been a chef for Kansas City Royals and specializes in smoked meats. He also would like to host craft beer pairings with different menu items. He will train a chef and manage the restaurant. He will offer delivery.

Jim Hackney mentioned that lessee must ask the Board before making changes to the building. He also thought a “meet the owners” night would give the patrons an opportunity to try the new menu.

Kaleb Forkner will check on the liquor license and provide Joe with a tournament schedule so he will know in advance of upcoming events.
