Roll Call

1. Jim Hackney **called the meeting to order. Members in attendance:** Jim Hackney, Elbert Smith, Marcus Patton, Mike Moudy, Stephanie Patterson. Absent: Tammy Thomas, Jason Teeter

2. Agenda—to discuss, provide input, and support the Briarbrook Community Improvement District Board of Directors in applying for a Federal Trails Grant to restore the trails on the golf course by replacing the deteriorated trails to safe, user friendly concrete trails.

Elbert Smith moved to accept the agenda. Mike Moudy seconded. Motion passed.

Jim Hackney reported that the Board has to answer 30 questions concerning the Trails Grant. For Example:

1. Purpose
2. Handicap accessible
3. Sign up sheet to demonstrate public support with picture of project—sign up sheet in Pro Shop
4. Deed to show we own the property
5. Letter from the bank to show we have the money to complete the project with a 50/50 Grant.

There are 67 communities or public entities that are vying for the Grant and only 11 are granted. We have submitted the 1st application and they returned it for improvements.

If we make first cut, they will notify us. Then we must have engineers submit a cost estimate. Allgeier, Martin won't charge us to put cost estimate together. They will verify measurements of the next phase which includes trails along #11 and #16.

An independent board lets us know in October 2021, if we receive the grant. We pay for the project in advance, then they reimburse us.
